



Get onto the A3, heading south, in the direction of Portsmouth and Petersfield. Stay on the A3 and by-pass Guildford and, still on the A3 by-pass Milford. One and a half miles after the Milford turning follow the signs to Bowlhead Green. Go up the ramp from the A3 and turn left, back on yourself, driving parallel to the A3. Follow this lane until you come to the second sharp corner. Straight in front of you is the entrance to our drive, signed Heath Hall Farm and Heath End, so you do not go round the right-hand bend. Follow the red dashed line on map: Go up the drive to the top (about three quarters of a mile, narrow and bumpy) and at the top you turn left, pass a house on your right and we are the house on the next corner, a converted stable building - you may have to open a gate (which keeps foxes out and chickens in).

Alternatively, you can continue up the lane from the A3 (about a mile and a half) until you come to the village of Bowlhead Green which consists of a small cross-roads. There is a signpost in the middle, one arm of which points in the direction of Heath Hall and Lower House. Turn left down this lane and you will come to a house where you fork left. Follow the blue dotted line on map. Continue until you come to a gate which is usually closed. Just before this gate turn right and we are the house on the next corner. If you are coming from the Haslemere direction, this is the best way to get to the farm,

We have two driveways, both our own private drives, so you can approach the house from two directions.
